

ALA-APA Salary Survey: Non-MLS – Public and Academic

Quick Facts about the Non-MLS Salary Survey and a Preview of Data

- Salary Data from 62 public and academic library positions that do not require an ALA-Accredited Masters Degree in Library Science (MLS)
- Data from 26,937 individuals working at 836 libraries
- Salaries ranged from \$10,707 (federal minimum wage) to \$141,924
- Salaries reported by region, state and required educational degree

Sample of Positions Included

- Associate Librarians in nine functional areas (average salary for Children's/Young Adult Services was \$33,561 public and \$29,786 academic)
- Library Technical Assistants in ten functional areas (average salary for Reference was \$30,818 public and \$29,843 academic)
- Clerks in 11 functional areas (average salary for Acquisitions Clerk was \$31,018 public and \$28,790 academic)
- Information Technology Managers (average salary was \$56,822 public and \$51,214 academic)
- Graphic Artists (average salary was \$38,921 public and \$37,934 academic)
- Public Relations Officers (average salary was \$47,908 public and \$40,965 academic)
- Receptionists (average salary was \$29,333 public and \$27,557 academic)
- Human Resources Managers (average salary was \$63,250 public and \$46,805 academic)
- Senior Accountants (average salary was \$55,449 public and \$42,794 academic)
- Building Maintenance (average salary was \$35,991 public and \$25,937 academic)
- Grant Proposal Writer (average salary was \$53,655 public and \$49,613 academic)
- Copy Cataloger (average salary was \$32,997 public and \$31,614 academic)
- Driver (average salary was \$27,950 public and \$26,176 academic)
- Shelver/Page (average salary was \$18,068 public and \$17,062 academic)
